We will also engage in creating our own journey tales, experiencing and exploring life in the Gambia using our 5 senses, and creating our own healthy living dish!

## Our Learning Overview

Key Texts In English, we will be using our Talk for Writing skills to adapt and create our own adventure tale, based on "Grace & Family". We will revisit and extend on our prior **English** learning, using our descriptive writing skills to purposefully engage our readers. We will also learn the features of informative letter writing and write our own letters as Grace! In maths, we will revisit our prior learning of place value, addition and subtraction. We will build on our previous skills through exploration of numbers within 100. We will Maths compare and order numbers, identifying tens and ones, using fluency, reasoning and problem solving skills. In science, we will be exploring animals including humans, using scientific terms to learn On the High Street about the life cycles of humans and a variety of animals. We will be using classification Science skills and revisiting previous learning to embed our scientific inquiry and investigative skills. In computing, we will be revisiting internet safety rules: understanding the importance of Computing witholding personal information, trusted websites and apps, and recognising false information and accounts. In history, we will learn about trade in our local area. We will explore the timeline of trade in Bexley Road, researching how shopping has developed since 1930. We will also learn History & about significant figures that have contributed to the evolvement of trade, making Geography comparisons between engineers previously studied, and how that has impacted future trade. In RE, we will learn about Judaism, focusing on what they believe in: this includes RE Jewish life, special day of the week (Shabbat), and the importance and value of celebration. In DT, we will learn about food hygiene and safety and how to manage risk. We will Art/DT experience tasting fruits and vegetables and learn how to prepare them before designing, making and evaluating a food product.
