A MESSAGE FROM OUR HEAD TEACHER

Dear parents and carers

As we reach the end of another great week at Northumberland Heath, there is so much to share with you to bring you up to date with all the wonderful things going on at our school.

Our Nursery took their first visit to Forest School this week. We are so lucky to have our Forest School provision where children are able to engage first hand with the natural world and learn key skills in communication, physical development, and social and emotional development. As you can see from the pictures, they had great fun whilst learning and enjoyed the mud particularly!

Time Capsule Education held sessions with years 4 and 5 to immerse them in their topics of Vikings and space. These visits were aimed at giving children drama experiences based in knowledge of the topics which support children's work over the topic.

Our relationships and behaviour approaches are rooted in self-esteem, restoration and positive relationships. 'Positive noticing' is a cornerstone of what we do. We, along with other trust schools, are engaging in Positive Noticing Day on Wednesday 16th November where children are encouraged to notice behaviours and qualities in each other which should be celebrated. We are really looking forward to this event where we will celebrate all our wonderful children and everything they do.

It is really important to read every day with your child and we would like to invite parents in to discuss how they can support their child read at home. Next week's Friday coffee drop-in will be led by Miss Allen, who will talk parents about how to inspire a love of reading for children at home and talk through any challenges you may have. Please come and meet Miss Allen next Friday (18th November) from 8.45 in the Book Barn. There will be refreshments provided!


