All week we have had our parent learning afternoons and the Year 3 gallery. Thank you to those parents who were able to come along, we hope you had fun learning with your child.



This week in Year 1, we have been exploring measurement, focusing on length, height, mass, and capacity. We've had the opportunity to use a variety of hands-on tools, such as rulers, scales, and containers, to support and enhance our learning.

Bluebells have enjoyed a great week of learning outdoors in the sunshine. We have been exploring Forest School, we made a Stickman and found sticks that looked like numbers. We created a bug hotel for the mini beasts to live in and made mud pies in different sizes. We also welcomed parents and carers in to do some potting of our spider plant babies, they all got to take one home to look after. We have been learning all about what living things need to survive and how we can look after them and help them grow.

In Year 2 this week, we have been sewing up a storm! In our DT lesson we created a coin pouch. We cut out the template, traced it, cut out the felt and then used a real sewing needle. 


Year Three
