We hope you had a lovely half term and enjoyed spending quality time together.

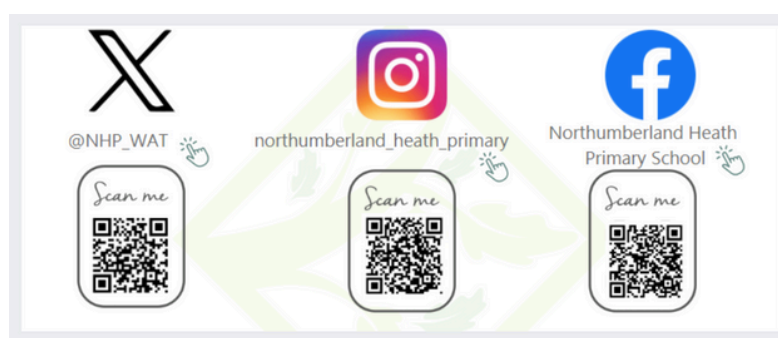
