The weather looks set to be very warm this week, so take care in the sun and have a wonderful weekend!

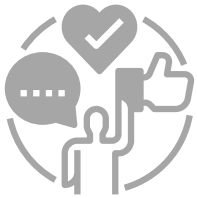

BEHAVIOUR



As you know we have been working hard to improve the behaviour at Northumberland Heath and it has improved greatly. We have put a variety of things in place to ensure that children feel safe and secure. Expectations are clearly communicated with clarity around the Relationship and Behaviour policy to ensure a unified and consistent approach to consequences and rewards.

Within each classroom there is a recognition board that encourages children to work together to be rewarded with golden coins. Once a certain amount is collected the class will enjoy reward time together.



Excellent behaviour for learning resulting in high quality work produced by a child is also recognised. The child's name is written in a special golden book, their name written on a glittery star and displayed outside the Headship office proudly for all to see. The child is further rewarded with a golden ticket which enables them to have milkshake with SLT on a Friday.

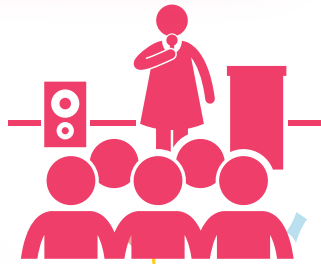
