Please look out for further information regarding Red Nose Day, Easter celebrations and looking forwards to the King's coronation.

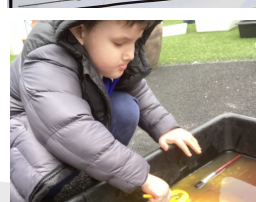
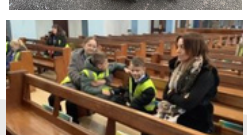
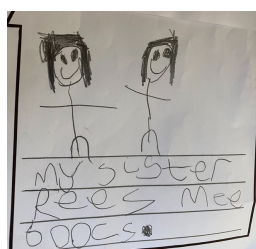
