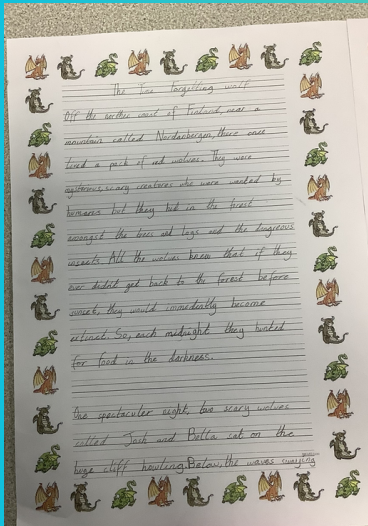

TEACHING AND LEARNING



KS1

In year 1, children have been completing 'Dough Disco' to support with fine motor skills. They have been completing hand exercises to support the development of the muscles in their hands. This has helped children to develop their writing and has also been a fun activity for the children to enjoy!

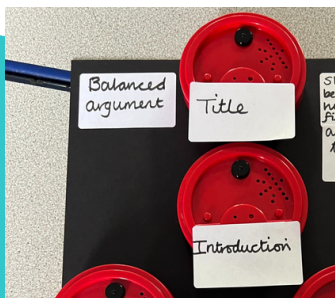
Year 2 have been using Manipulatives in Maths to Partition numbers in different ways using Dienes and ones.

In year 3, we have been using a mythical tale called 'The Stone Trolls.' The children have used the model text to write their own warning tales and have created some fantastic writing.

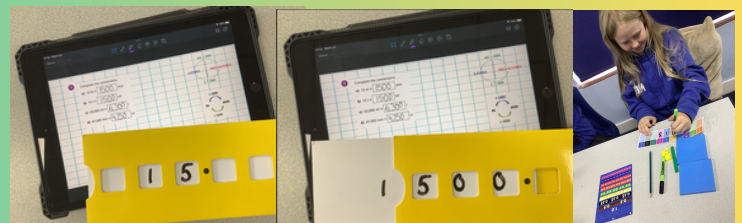

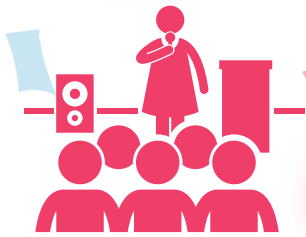
