How did the discovery of Bronze, impact the lives of people in The Stone Age?

Big Bang Day	Big bang session: Tuesday 10th September 2024

Mathematics

This term, we will be learning about place value focusing on representing and partitioning numbers to 1,000. We are also going to explore both formal and informal methods of addition and subtraction.

Writing

This term, the children will be writing their own portal stories about a child who visits the Stone Age time period while developing their skills around creating a setting description.

Personal Development

Children will learn about healthy relationships and how to build character based upon British values.

History

Children will explore the Stone Age, Bronze Age and Iron Age in chronological order, through identifying the key features of each time period.

Science

Children will learn how to sort and classify rocks based on different properties. We will also look at the rock cycle and discover how different rocks are formed.

Art and DT

This term, we will develop our sketching skills to create illustrations based on cave paintings.

Physical Education

This term's focus will be football and swimming.

Religious Education

During RE week, children will explore the importance of the Bible and what it means to Christians.
