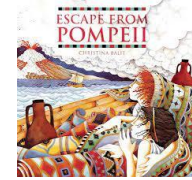


Our topic this term is

Tectonics



In English, we will use our core text *Escape from Pompeii* to create an action tale. We will also be writing some non-fiction pieces around natural disasters.

In Maths, we will be focusing on multiplication and division, perimeter and measurements.

In Science, we will learn all about the different types of rocks and how to identify them. We will conduct a simple test to sort the rocks based on their properties.

In RE, we will continue to explore the importance of the Bible to Christians. We will explore the question 'Why is the Bible important for Christians today'?

In Computing, we continue to learn about programming and coding, and explore additional features of our iPad and how they can support our learning.

In Art, we will be looking at the at the Pop Art of Andy Warhol, and creating our own versions using our knowledge of the colour wheel.

In Music, will be focusing on glockenspiels. The children will also be learning notes on the treble clef stave and musical terms.

In our Wider Curriculum, we will be learning about how the Earth is formed, and understand how tectonics operate on the planet. We will consider how some parts of the world experience natural disasters due to their location. This will build on our existing knowledge of continents and physical geography.

In Personal Development, we will continue to discuss the reasons for rules and why we should respect them. We will also look at the United Nation's Convention on the Rights of the Child.
