



## Year 4 Curriculum Overview - Autumn 1

# Why are rivers important to humans?

**Big Bang Day** Our Big Bang session will be on Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> September 2024

### Mathematics

This term, the children will be developing their fluency and reasoning in place value. We will extend our knowledge to numbers involving 10,000 and further. We are also going to explore both formal and informal methods of addition and subtraction.

### Writing

Children will be writing their own diary entries about a whale in the River Thames.

### Personal Development

Children will learn about different relationships and how to develop good character and the British Values.

### Geography

Children will explore a range of sources to identify the physical characteristics of world rivers. They will be able to name the features of a river and explore its profile.

### Science

Children will be learning about living things and their habitats. They will be looking at dichotomous keys and using them in their classification of living things.

### Art and DT

This half term the children will be creating water images using water colour techniques.

### Physical Education

This half term, children will be working on their coordination by participating in football.

### Religions Education

During RE week, the children will explore the meaning of Hinduism, why people have faith and the impact it has on their lives.

### Computing

Children will be learning about social media and will focus on understanding digital footprints, age limits and laws. They will learn how to use it technology safely and positively.
