Topic Overview Big Bang Day	We will be exploring 'Why does the Kingdom of Benin not exist today?'  Our Big Bang session will be on Tuesday, 10 <sup>th</sup> September 2024	CHILDREN OF THE BENIN KINGDOM
Mathematics	This term, the children will be developing their fluency and reasoning in place value. They will extend their knowledge to numbers involving 100,000 and further. They are also going to explore both formal and informal methods of addition and subtraction.

Personal Development	Children will learn how to manage their friendships and learn about our school's value of respect: how we can show respect to our peers and adults, too.
